About the Coalition for the Homeless of Central Florida

Coalition for the Homeless has grown from a church outreach program to a full-service nonprofit agency that provides shelter, meals, education, job training and comprehensive social services, with the goal of returning its clients to self-sufficiency.

The Coalition is the largest provider of homeless services in Central Florida and the largest residential facility for children. It is the largest residential emergency shelter in the region that accepts intact families and keeps them together.

Coalition for the Homeless receives less than 30% of its funding from government sources. The Coalition relies on its fundraising events and the donations of individuals, businesses, corporations, foundations, and faith-based organizations in the Central Florida area for 70% of its resources.

In Central Florida, the fastest growing segment of the homeless population is families with children. On a given night, the Coalition provides services to nearly 200 children. Their average age is under seven years old.

Programs overview

The Center for Women and Families (CWF) houses 240 residents comprised of single parents with children, single women, and intact families. The Coalition's second campus, the Women's Residential Counseling Center (WRCC), can accommodate 138 women and children, including 12 beds for crisis situations. Seventy-three percent of WRCC residents are victims of crime, predominantly domestic violence. Case managers in both facilities design self-sufficiency plans for each resident, to include education and employment options; job skills training; psychological counseling; and life skills training, such as managing a budget and establishing a savings account. The Coalition also coordinates medical, visual and dental care services through its partnerships with various local agencies.

As part of the family case management plan, each child's psychological needs are determined. Those who are deemed "at risk" or "in-crisis" receive intervention services such as individual and group counseling, play therapy and family therapy. Other children's services include academic tutoring, a fully licensed day care facility, after school and summer programs, and the Art By Coalition Children (ABCs) Program.

The Men's Pavilion is a traditional drop-in shelter that can house up to 375 men. Clients of the drop-in shelter with substance abuse issues are encouraged to enter the First Steps Program, a residential substance abuse recovery program for homeless men. A similar First Steps for Women has been initiated in the Center for Women and Families.
