Facility type, placement	One story, semi-enclosed structure Will be torn down after replacement is built	Two-level building of solid construction To be built on main campus, backing to Ossie Street
Facility environment	Not of adequate size to make available Individualized Program Plan and supportive services to all the men.	Suitable environment in which issues unique to homeless men can be addressed. Will include a meeting space; offices for agency and partner provider staff.
Number of men	Maximum capacity is 375 men	Will accommodate 250 men
Sleeping accommodations	On floor mats (with exception of 36-bed First Steps Substance Abuse Recovery Program); All in one large room	Separate quarters with beds for special populations, i.e. First Steps substance abuse recovery; physically disabled; military veterans
Dining facilities	Sleeping and dining in same large room	Dedicated dining room and kitchen
